



# 04 Internship

The Internship Program period of this Emotional Intelligence program consists of a 3-week placement at a prestigious institution, from Monday through Friday with 8-hour consecutive shifts of practical training alongside a supervising specialist. This internship will allow you to see how emotional strategies are implemented in the educational environment, observing first-hand the application of self-regulation techniques, conflict resolution, and affective communication.

In this completely practical Internship Program, the activities are aimed at developing and perfecting the skills necessary to provide educational services in areas and conditions that require a high level of qualification.

This is an ideal opportunity to learn by working in an innovative center, where real-time management and monitoring of the emotional climate is the cornerstone of the educational culture. This new way of understanding and integrating emotional processes makes this institution the ideal teaching environment for this transformative experience in the improvement of the emotional and leadership skills of the 21st-century teaching team.

The practical part will be carried out with the active participation of the student performing the activities and procedures of each area of competence (learning to learn and learning to do), with the support and guidance of teachers and other training colleagues who facilitate teamwork and multidisciplinary integration as cross-cutting skills for the practice of Emotional Intelligence (learning to be and learning to relate).

<b>Social-emotional development in Pre-School teachers</b>	Detect and manage professional stress in Pre-School teachers, promoting emotional self-regulation in the school environment
	Foster emotional awareness, helping teachers identify and name their emotions and those of their students
	Implement emotional training programs focused on self-control, empathy, and decision-making in the classroom
	Implement group emotional reflection sessions, where experiences, emotions, and challenges specific to working with young children are addressed
<b>Pedagogical leadership</b>	Mediate school conflicts from an emotionally intelligent approach, helping to resolve tensions between students, teachers, or families with emotional regulation strategies
	Implement emotional leadership methodologies in the management of school projects, pedagogical innovations, or coexistence plans
	Assess the emotional climate of the school, identifying areas for improvement to promote more humane, inclusive, and safe school environments
	Collaborate in the design of institutional improvement plans, integrating emotional and healthy leadership indicators
<b>Educational Coaching Strategies</b>	Design individual or group coaching sessions that promote reflection, decision-making, and emotional management in students
	Facilitate the development of social-emotional skills such as empathy, resilience, assertiveness, and active listening in the classroom
	Guide processes to improve the school climate through interventions focused on peaceful conflict resolution, affective communication, and collaborative work
	Develop self-awareness and emotional leadership dynamics with the aim of educating conscious, autonomous, and emotionally competent students



# 06

## General Conditions

### Civil Liability Insurance

The university's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the interns, other collaborating professionals involved in the internship process at the center. Among the measures dedicated to achieve this is the response to any incident that may occur during the entire teaching-learning process.

To this end, the university commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the stay at the internship center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the Internship Program period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.



## General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship agreement for the program are as follows:

**1. TUTOR:** During the Internship Program, students will be assigned two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

**2. DURATION:** The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

**3. ABSENCE:** If the student does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

**4. CERTIFICATION:** Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

**5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP:** The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

**6. PRIOR EDUCATION** Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the TECH internship department so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

**7. DOES NOT INCLUDE:** The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult with their academic tutor for any questions or recommendations in this regard. The academic tutor will provide the student with all the necessary information to facilitate the procedures in any case.
