General Objectives

Internship

The Internship Program period of this Speech, Language and Communication Disorders program consists of a 3-week practical stay at a leading Institution, from Monday to Friday with shifts of 8 consecutive hours of practical training alongside an assistant specialist.

In this completely practical Internship Program, the activities are aimed at developing and honing the skills necessary for the provision of teaching practice. In this way, graduates will develop personalized intervention plans to help students overcome their Speech, Language and Communication Disorders.

It is undoubtedly a unique opportunity to learn while working in an innovative educational environment, where the development and improvement of the linguistic and communication skills of students with speech and language disorders are the focus of attention. This is a new way of understanding and integrating communication processes in the classroom, and makes the school environment the ideal setting for this practical experience, aimed at honing the pedagogical skills of teachers in caring for students with difficulties in the 21st century.

The practical part will be carried out with the active participation of the student performing the activities and procedures of each area of competence (learning to learn and learning to do), with the accompaniment and guidance of professors and other fellow trainees who facilitate teamwork and multidisciplinary integration as transversal competencies for the practice of Speech, Language and Communication Disorders (learning to be and learning to relate).

The procedures described below will be the basis of the practical part of the program, and their implementation will be subject to the center's own availability and workload, the proposed activities being the following:





Module	Practical Activity
Approaching Dyslexia	Analyze student behavior during reading and writing activities
	Use simple tests or activities to assess reading and writing skills, such as reading fluency, word recognition and text comprehension
	Modify the learning environment to meet the needs of the student with dyslexia, such as providing more time to complete tasks
	Apply intervention programs designed to address reading and writing difficulties, such as multisensory programs
Specific Language Impairment Techniques	Identify signs of language delays compared to other children of the same age, such as difficulty forming complete sentences
	Modify teaching to facilitate the student's language learning
	Use visual aids (such as pictograms, graphics or concept maps) to support oral and written comprehension and expression
	Create opportunities for the student to actively participate in conversation, both orally and in writing
Verbal Fluency Disorders	Conduct an initial assessment of the student's verbal fluency using specific tools that detect patterns of interruption in speech, such as repetitions, blocks and prolongations of sounds
	Implement strategies to support the student in oral situations, such as giving more time to respond, offering the option to respond in writing or allowing for smaller presentations in less intimidating environments
	Create a judgment-free classroom environment where students feel comfortable expressing themselves without fear of ridicule, helping to reduce the anxiety associated with Stuttering
	Applying relaxation techniques to help students manage the stress associated with stuttering
Psychological Support	Identify emotional problems that interfere with language development, such as extreme shyness, social anxiety or low self-esteem, which can affect the student's willingness to communicate
	Offer emotional support to students with communication difficulties, helping to reduce the fear and anxiety associated with the act of speaking
	Create an inclusive environment that minimizes barriers for students with speech or language difficulties
	Use psychological principles, such as social learning theory and modeling, to teach communication skills

General Conditions

Civil Liability Insurance

The university's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the interns, other collaborating professionals involved in the internship process at the center. Among the measures dedicated to achieve this is the response to any incident that may occur during the entire teaching-learning process.

To this end, the university commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the course of the internship at the center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the Internship Program period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.



General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship program agreement shall be as follows:

1. TUTOR: During the Internship Program, students will be assigned with two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned with an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

2. DURATION: The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

3. ABSENCE: If the students does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

4. CERTIFICATION: Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP: The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

6. PRIOR EDUCATION: Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the TECH internship department so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

7. DOES NOT INCLUDE: The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult with their academic tutor for any questions or recommendations in this regard. The academic tutor will provide the student with all the necessary information to facilitate the procedures in any case.
