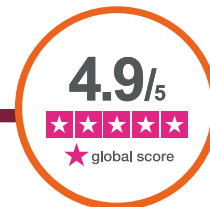

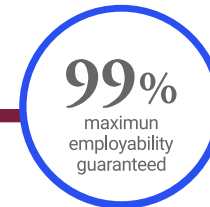

## Teaching Objectives

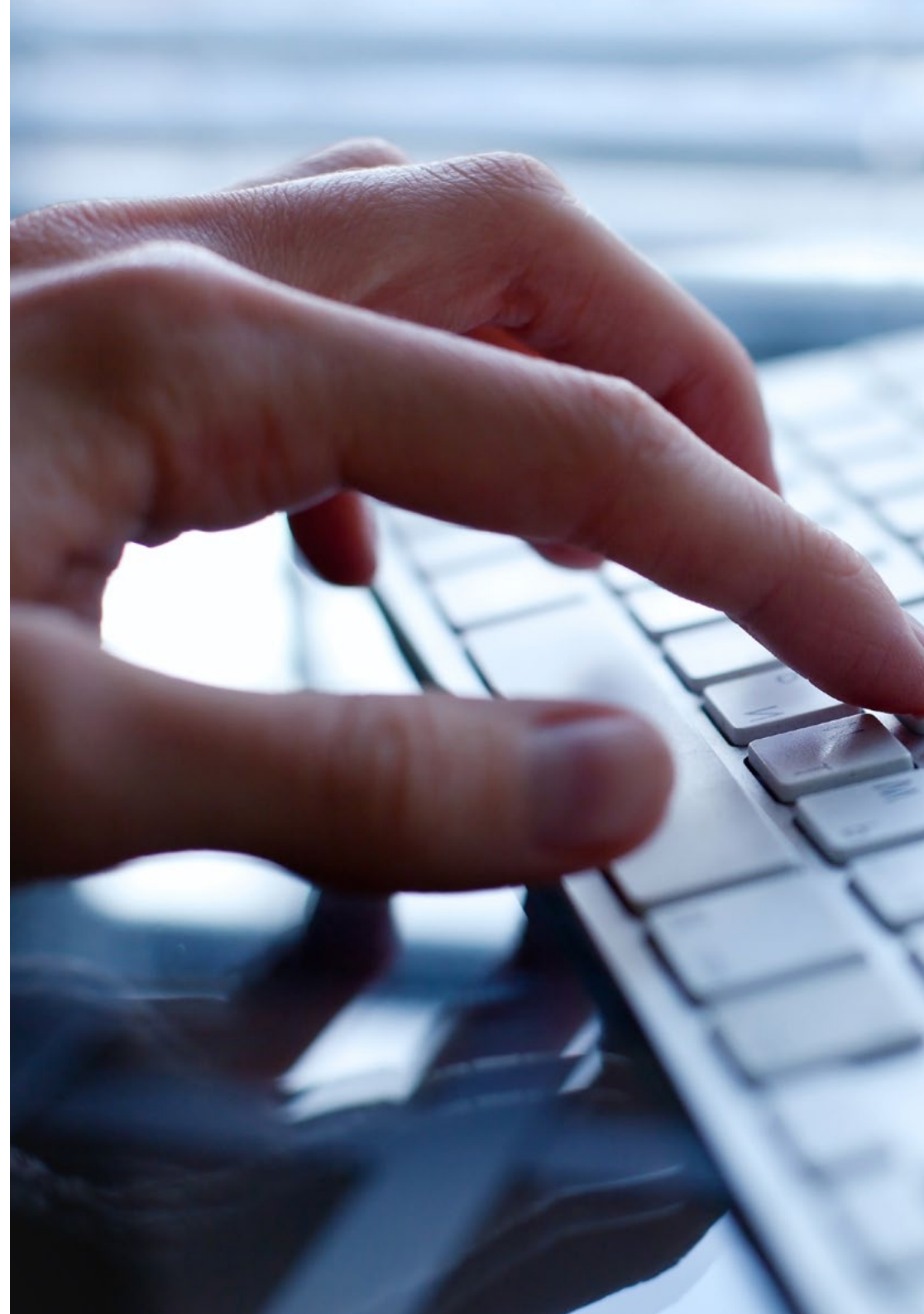

- Examine different cases of violations of International Humanitarian Law, including civilian victims and even the impact on the environment

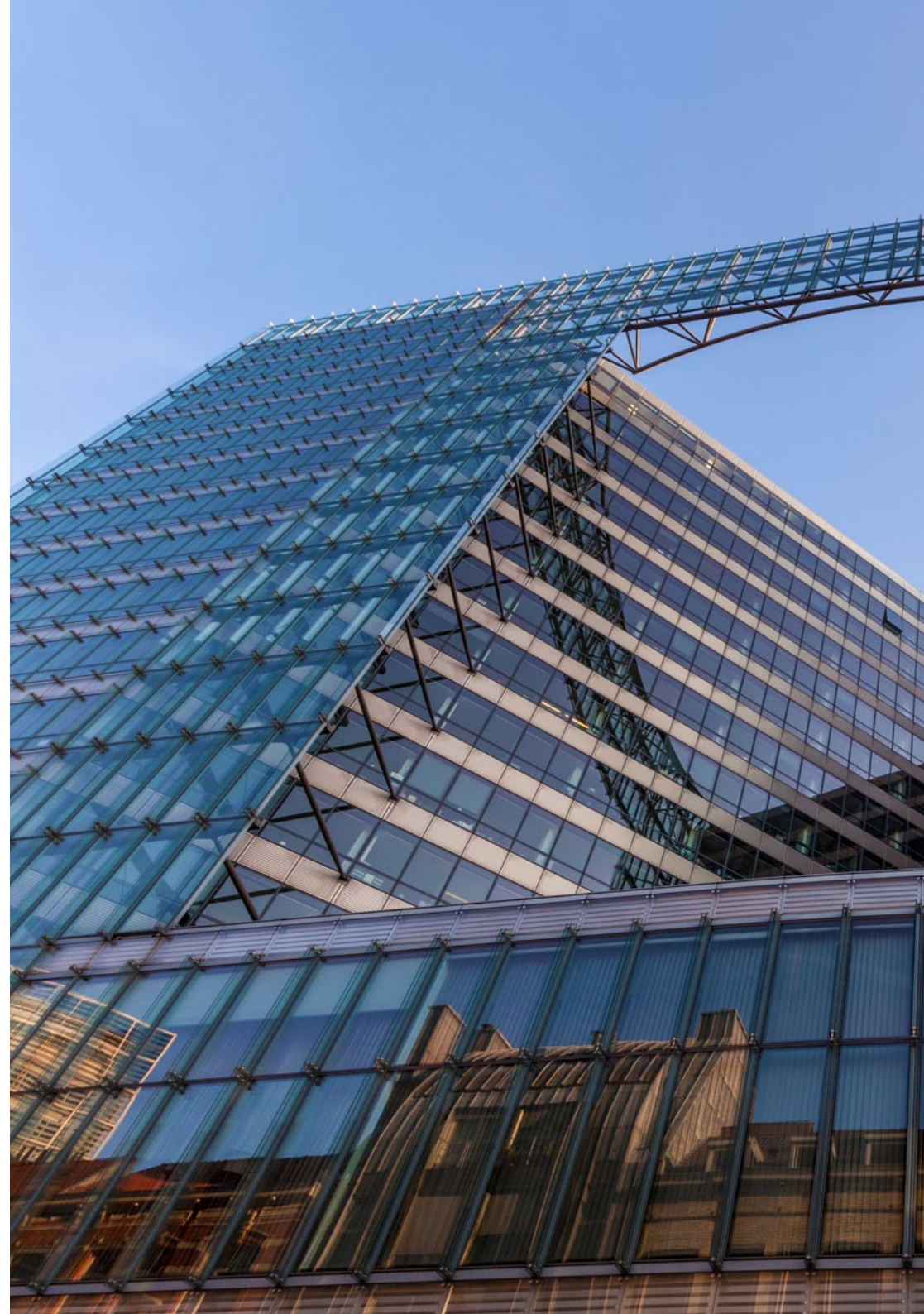
# 04 Internship

The practical training period of this Human Rights program consists of a practical placement in a prestigious organization, lasting 3 weeks, from Monday to Friday with consecutive 8-hour days of practical training alongside an assigned specialist. This placement will allow students to develop key competencies in the defense and promotion of fundamental principles, strengthening their skills in legal analysis, mediation, and intervention strategies in diverse contexts.

In this training proposal, each activity is designed to strengthen and refine the key competencies required for specialized practice in this field. In this way, the professional profile will be enhanced, driving a strong, efficient, and highly competitive performance.

It is undoubtedly an opportunity to learn by working in an innovative environment where the protection and promotion of Human Rights are the central axis of its institutional culture. It represents a new way of understanding and integrating the principles of dignity, equality, and justice into every process, making this space an ideal setting for reflection, learning, and the refinement of competencies in the defense and guarantee of fundamental rights in the 21st century.

The practical component will be carried out with the active participation of students performing the activities and procedures of each area of competence (learning to learn and learning to do), with the support and guidance of instructors and fellow trainees who facilitate teamwork and multidisciplinary integration as transversal competencies for the practice of Law (learning to be and learning to relate).







The procedures described below will be the basis of the practical part of the Internship Program, and its realization will be subject to the center's own availability and workload, being the proposed activities the following:

# 06

## General Conditions

### Civil Liability Insurance

The university's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the interns, other collaborating professionals involved in the internship process at the center. Among the measures aimed at achieving this objective is the provision of coverage in response to any incident that may occur throughout the entire teaching–learning process.

To this end, the university commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the stay at the internship center. To this end, the university undertakes to contract liability insurance that will cover any eventuality that may arise during the internship period at the placement center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the Internship Program period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.





## General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship agreement for the program are as follows:

**1. TUTOR:** During the Internship Program, students will be assigned two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

**2. DURATION:** The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

**3. ABSENCE:** If the student does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

**4. CERTIFICATION:** Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

**5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP:** The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

**6. PRIOR EDUCATION** Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the internship department at TECH so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

**7. 3.- DOES NOT INCLUDE:** The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult their academic tutor regarding any questions or recommendations in this respect. The tutor will provide all necessary information to facilitate the corresponding procedures.
