The Internship Program in Home Hospitalization consists of a practical stay in a prestigious center, a 3-week period, from Monday to Friday with 8 consecutive hours of work with an attending specialist. This will allow the student to apply the latest precepts in the area to cases and real patients, monitoring and carrying out an exhaustive follow-up of them.

In this program proposal, which is completely practical, the activities are aimed at developing and perfecting the competencies necessary for the provision of Home Hospitalization, and are oriented towards specific expertise for the exercise of the activity, in a safe environment for the patient and with highly professional performance.

It is undoubtedly , an opportunity to learn by working in the innovative hospital of the future , where real-time health monitoring and personalized attention of patients is at the center of the digital culture of its professionals. This is a new way of understanding and integrating healthcare processes, and turns a reference center into the ideal teaching scenario for this innovative experience in the improvement of professional skills.

The practical education will be carried out with the active participation of the student performing the activities and procedures of each area of competence (learning to learn and learning to do), with the accompaniment and guidance of teachers and other fellow trainees who facilitate teamwork and multidisciplinary integration as transversal competencies for the practice of Home Hospitalization (learning to be and learning to relate).

Organization and Management of Home Hospitalization	Integrate in the daily tasks of coordination and management of a Home Hospitalization team
	Prepare and organize the clinical history of the Home Hospitalization Unit
	Become familiar with the most advanced organization and telemedicine technology
	Participate in the integral coordination of the patient before the admission decision, assessing indications and contraindications
Subsidiary syndromes of admission to the home and management of infections	Assess the limitations of home hospitalization according to the pathology presented
	Determine the equipment available (palliative, cardiovascular, respiratory, etc.) and the criteria to be taken into account for each case
	Analyze complementary examinations in cases of Home Hospitalization
	Manage special cases of Home Hospitalization, such as psychiatric or rehabilitation patients
Infections, pain and palliative care in Home Hospitalization	Manage home kinesic, respiratory and neuromuscular care with the appropriate tools
	Prepare the epicrisis of the patient in the Home Hospitalization unit based on admission criteria, exclusion or possible infections
	Coordinate with the psychopathology and family support services in the care of oncology patients
	Recognize possible complications, adverse effects or interactions of drugs administered in sedoanalgesia
Preventive medicine and special treatments in Home Hospitalization	Manage all the apparatus and approach methods related to peripheral and central lines, ostomies and tracheostomy cannula changes
	Practice the use of drains, use of bitubulated flasks and hemosuptores
	Dose the available material in the Home Hospitalization unit based on the circumstances and possibilities of each clinical case
	Practice decolonization of patients admitted to the Home Hospitalization unit after a long period in the ICU

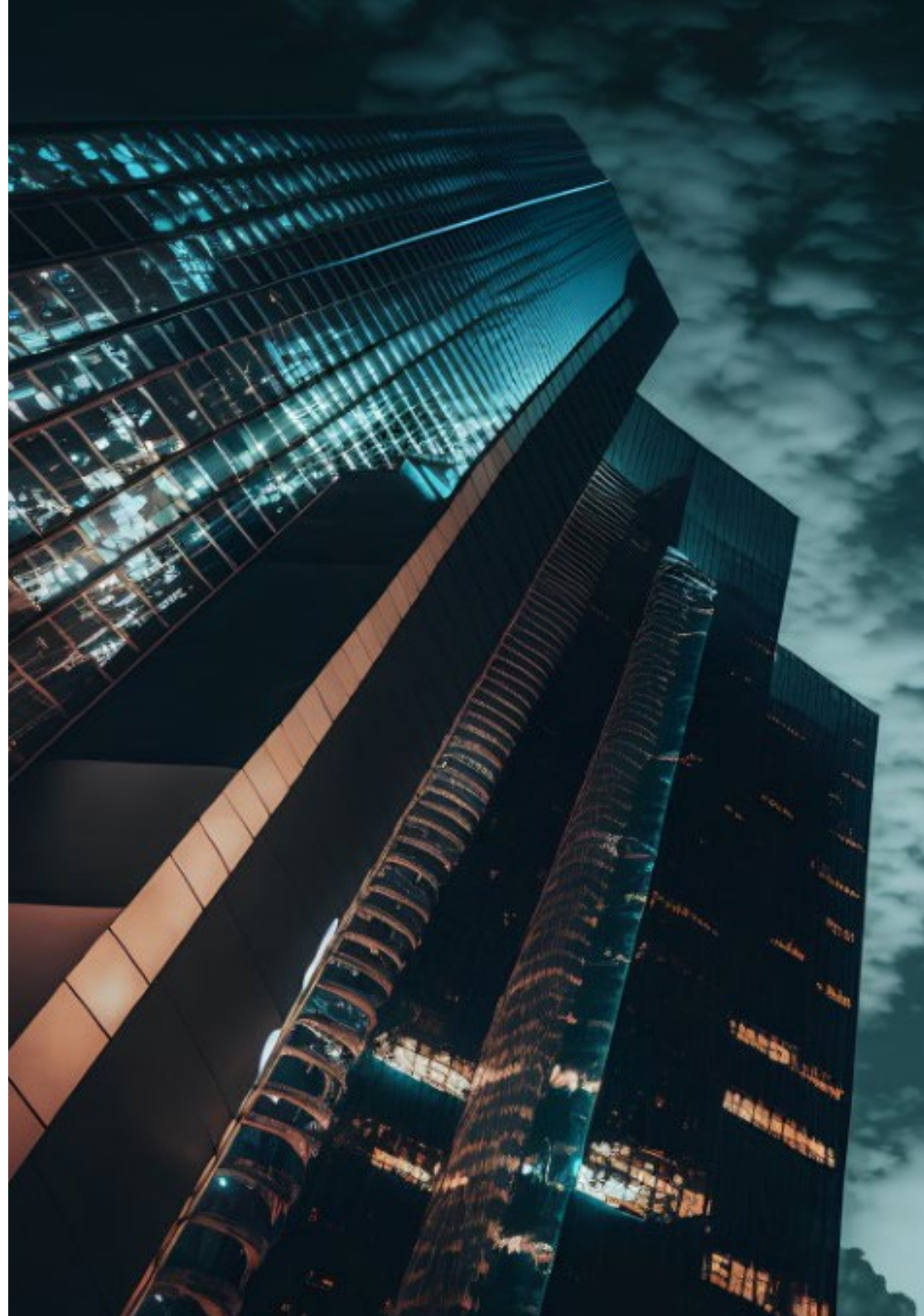
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Where Can I Do the Internship Program?

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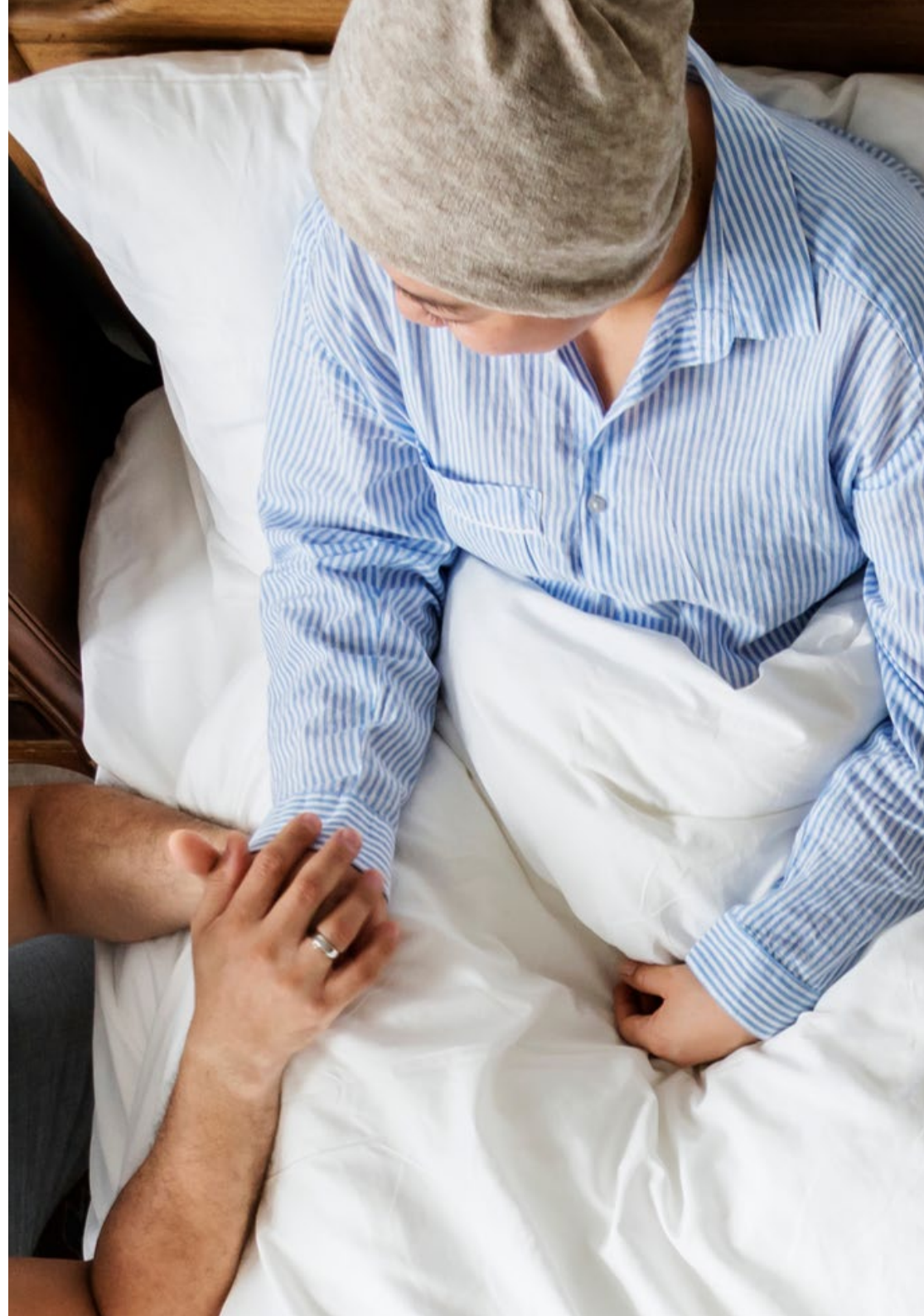
General Conditions

Civil Liability Insurance

This institution's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the trainees and other collaborating agents involved in the internship process at the company. Among the measures dedicated to achieve this is the response to any incident that may occur during the entire teaching-learning process.

To this end, this entity commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the course of the internship at the center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the practical training period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.



General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship agreement for the program are as follows:

1. TUTOR: During the Internship Program, students will be assigned with two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned with an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

2. DURATION: The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

3. ABSENCE: If the students does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

4. CERTIFICATION: Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP: The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

6. PRIOR EDUCATION: Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the TECH internship department so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

7. DOES NOT INCLUDE: The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult with their academic tutor for any questions or recommendations in this regard. The academic tutor will provide the student with all the necessary information to facilitate the procedures in any case.
