In this completely practical Internship Program, the activities are aimed at developing and perfecting the skills necessary to provide healthcare in areas and conditions that require highly qualified professionals, and are oriented towards specific expertise for practicing the activity, in a safe environment for the patient and with highly professional performance.

It is undoubtedly an opportunity to learn by working in the innovative hospital of the future where real-time health monitoring of patients is at the center of the digital culture of its professionals. Patient Communication and Standardized Language Practice in Clinical Settings	Provide guidance, through the use of English, to different patients who need information related to various aspects such as: complaints, the development of doctoral theses, complaints and inconveniences, available services, etc.
	Indicate, if necessary, how to reach the different areas of the clinic through a fluent conversation of the clinic through a fluent conversation.
	Engage in conversations with patients and their families in order to provide them with information about the diagnosis or therapies to be followed for their recovery.
	Practice intonation and phonetics through communication with English-speaking patients from different regions.
Patient Management through Understanding Terms Related to Diagnosis and Treatment.	Establish pharmacological guidelines according to the patient's requirements and pathology through the mastery of therapeutic terms and their contraindications both in the native language and in English.
	Explain the psychological, physical and surgical therapeutic guidelines to the and surgical guidelines to the English-speaking patient.
	Rotate in the emergency area and attend to possible emergencies that come to the clinic emergencies that come to the clinical center through a fluid communication in order to calm the patient and their family members
	Conduct ICU health examinations and learn specific communication strategies for conveying bad news in English while minimizing stress.
Data Collection and Management in English	Participate in those cases in which the patient only understands English and must use this language to provide the clinical data necessary for the consultation.
	Conduct clinical interviews purely in English.
	Manage data management and analysis tools used in nursing in both English and the graduate's native language.
	Explain scanning procedures in detail for the English-speaking patient.
Specialized Care and Management of Equipment in the Hospital Environment	Help colleagues who are not fluent in English to understand medical records written in English.
	Care for the English-speaking patient through the mastery of terms referring to the following specialties: pediatrics, internal medicine, oncology, neurology, nephrology, cardiology, etc.
	Explain preoperative and postoperative care following the strictest language protocols to avoid misunderstandings in communication that could lead to patient health problems.
	Care for the patient at home with perfect command of English, also in crisis or pressure situations.
	Inform English-speaking patients of the hygienic, dietary and nutritional guidelines for their pathology.
	Use officially recognized nursing practice applications to communicate with the patient effectively if necessary
	Identify the clinical equipment used in the area in which the graduate will practice, as well as its characteristics, in order to be able to explain it in English to the patient, if necessary. to the patient if necessary

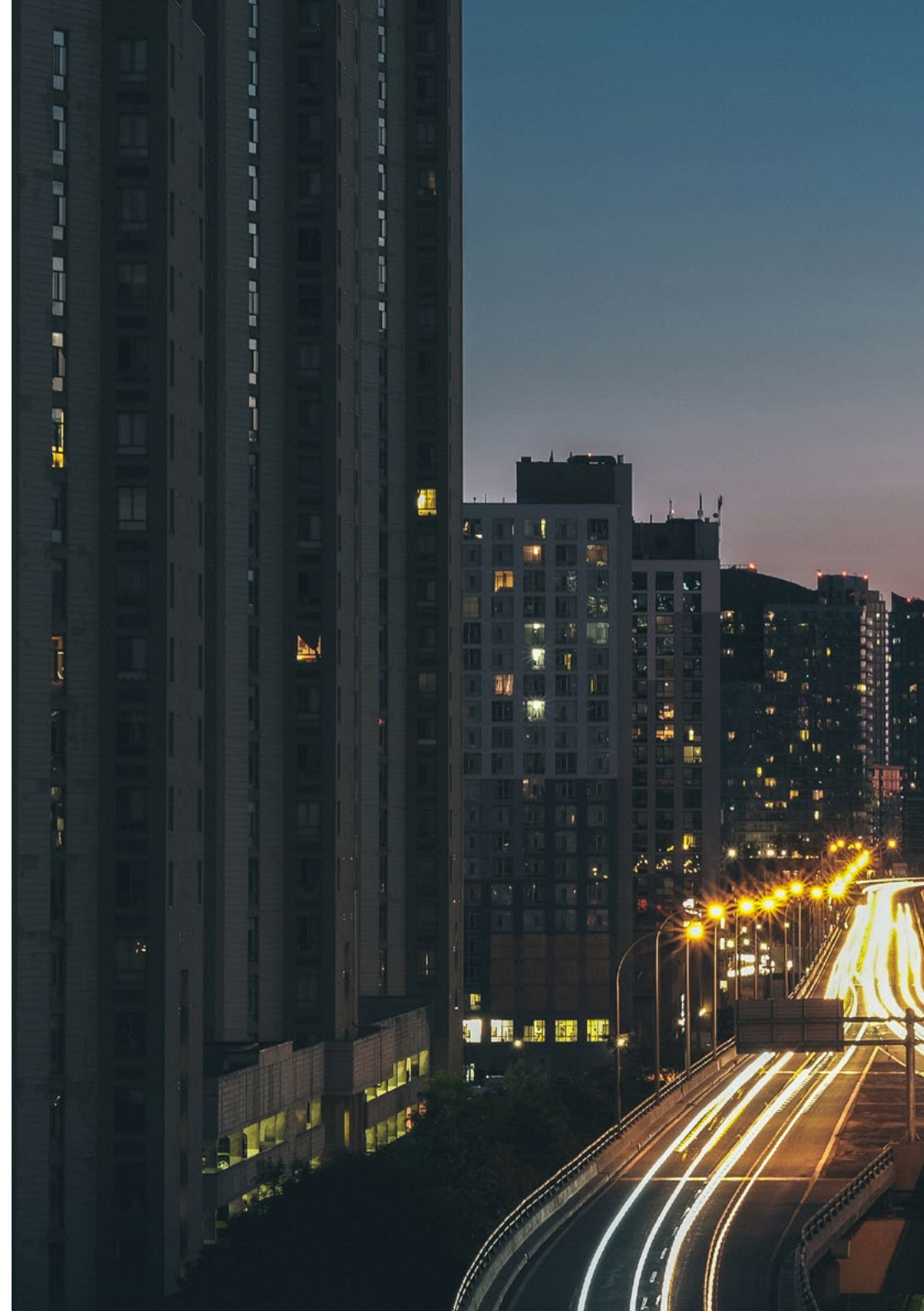

General Conditions

Civil Liability Insurance

This institution's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the trainees and other collaborating agents involved in the internship process at the company. Among the measures dedicated to achieve this is the response to any incident that may occur during the entire teaching-learning process.

To this end, this entity commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the course of the internship at the center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the practical training period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.



General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship program agreement shall be as follows:

1. TUTOR: During the Internship Program, students will be assigned with two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned with an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

2. DURATION: The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

3. ABSENCE: If the students does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

4. CERTIFICATION: Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP: The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

6. PRIOR EDUCATION: Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the TECH internship department so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

7. 3.- DOES NOT INCLUDE: The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult with their academic tutor for any questions or recommendations in this regard. The academic tutor will provide the student with all the necessary information to facilitate the procedures in any case.
