Likewise, oncologic pain is a very frequent symptom in geriatric patients that, due to its particularities, requires multidimensional management to ensure a good quality of life. It is essential for the student to detect early its manifestations and put in place the appropriate mechanisms for its resolution.





Did you know that this method was developed in 1912, at Harvard, for law students? In 1924, Harvard adopted it as a standard teaching method"

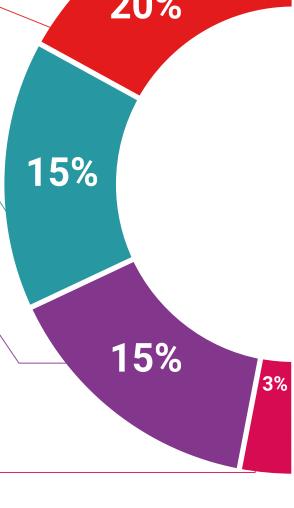
