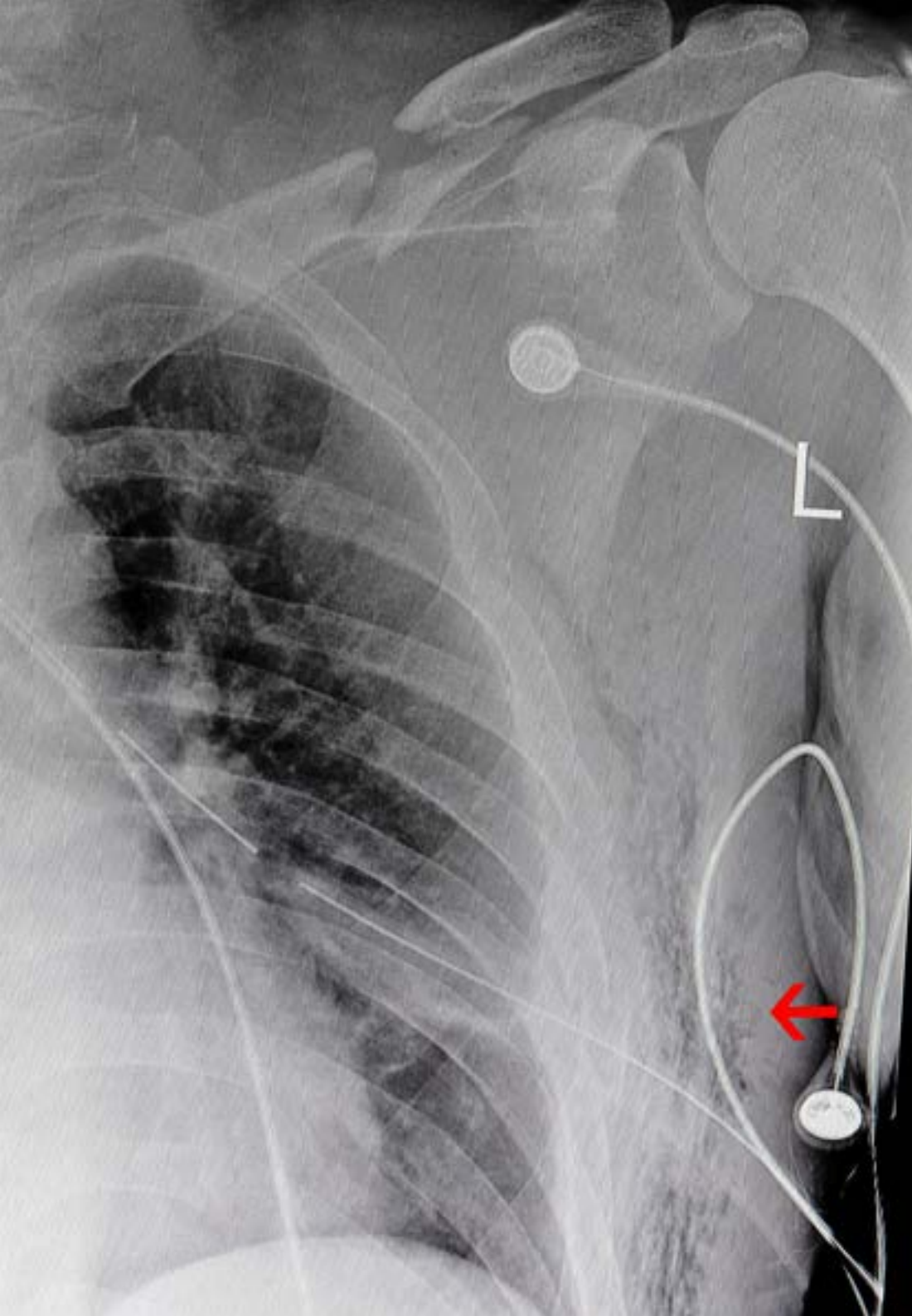

Methodology
