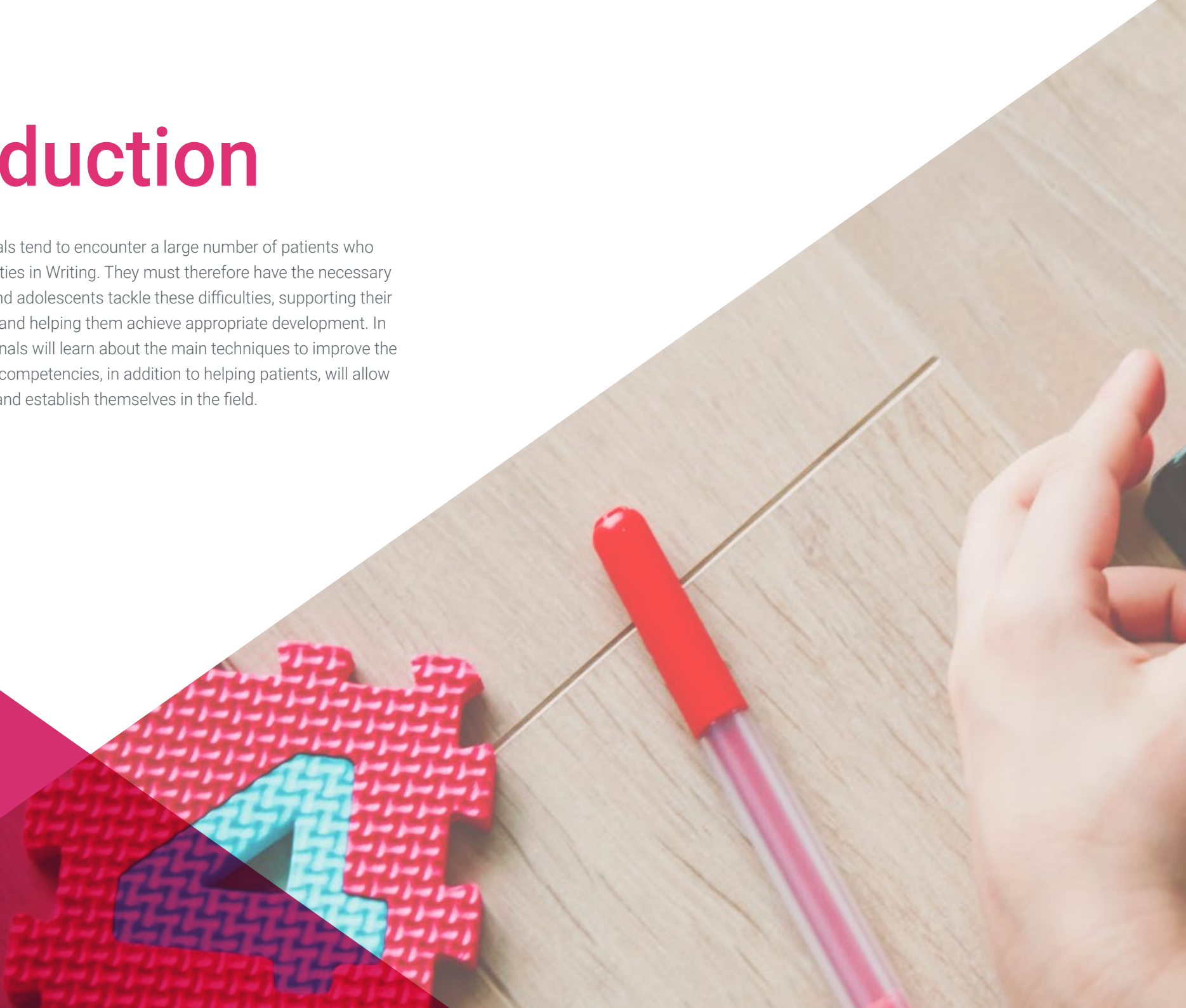

Introduction

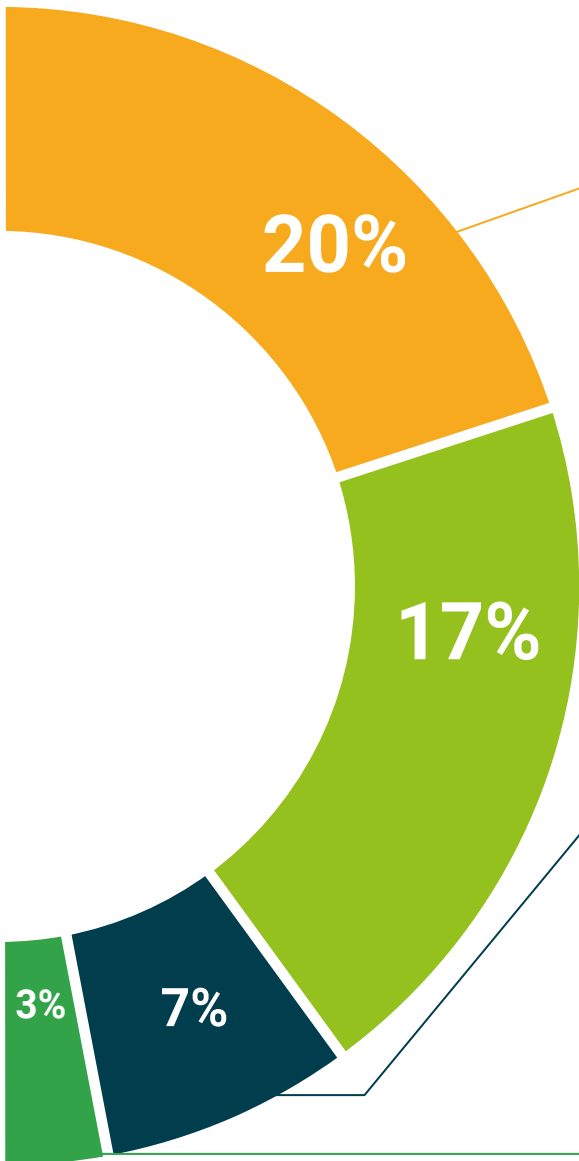
