



What are the A2 Level Skills?

Level A2 is part of basic User Level, which is divided into two sublevels: First and Second Basic User Level (A1 and A2).

Most of the descriptors that are used in social functions are found at this level, such as, for example:



Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of experience that are particularly relevant to him/her (basic information about him/herself and his/her family, shopping, places of interest, occupations, etc.)



Can communicate in simple, everyday tasks that require only simple and direct exchanges of information on familiar or routine matters



Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background and environment, as well as issues related to his/her immediate needs

The Professional Benefits of French

French is both a working language and an official language of the UN, the European Union, UNESCO, NATO, the International Olympic Committee, the International Red Cross and various other international legal bodies. French is the language of the three cities where the European institutions are located: Strasbourg, Brussels and Luxembourg.

According to the Observatoire de la langue Française, a French language control organization, around 220 million people speak French which puts it in 8th place on the list of most spoken languages on the planet. The Francophonie groups together 68 states and governments. French is the most studied foreign language after English.

Knowledge of French opens doors to French companies in France and abroad, in all francophone countries (Canada, Switzerland, Belgium, Africa). France, the fifth largest trading power and the third largest destination country for foreign investors, is a major economic partner.

Furthermore, speaking French allows you to study in France, in prestigious universities or in higher education business and engineering schools, ranked among the best higher teaching centers in Europe and worldwide. Students who are proficient in French can receive scholarships from the French Government to study a third year of their degree in France in all disciplines, and earn an internationally recognized diploma.

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Assessment and Certification
