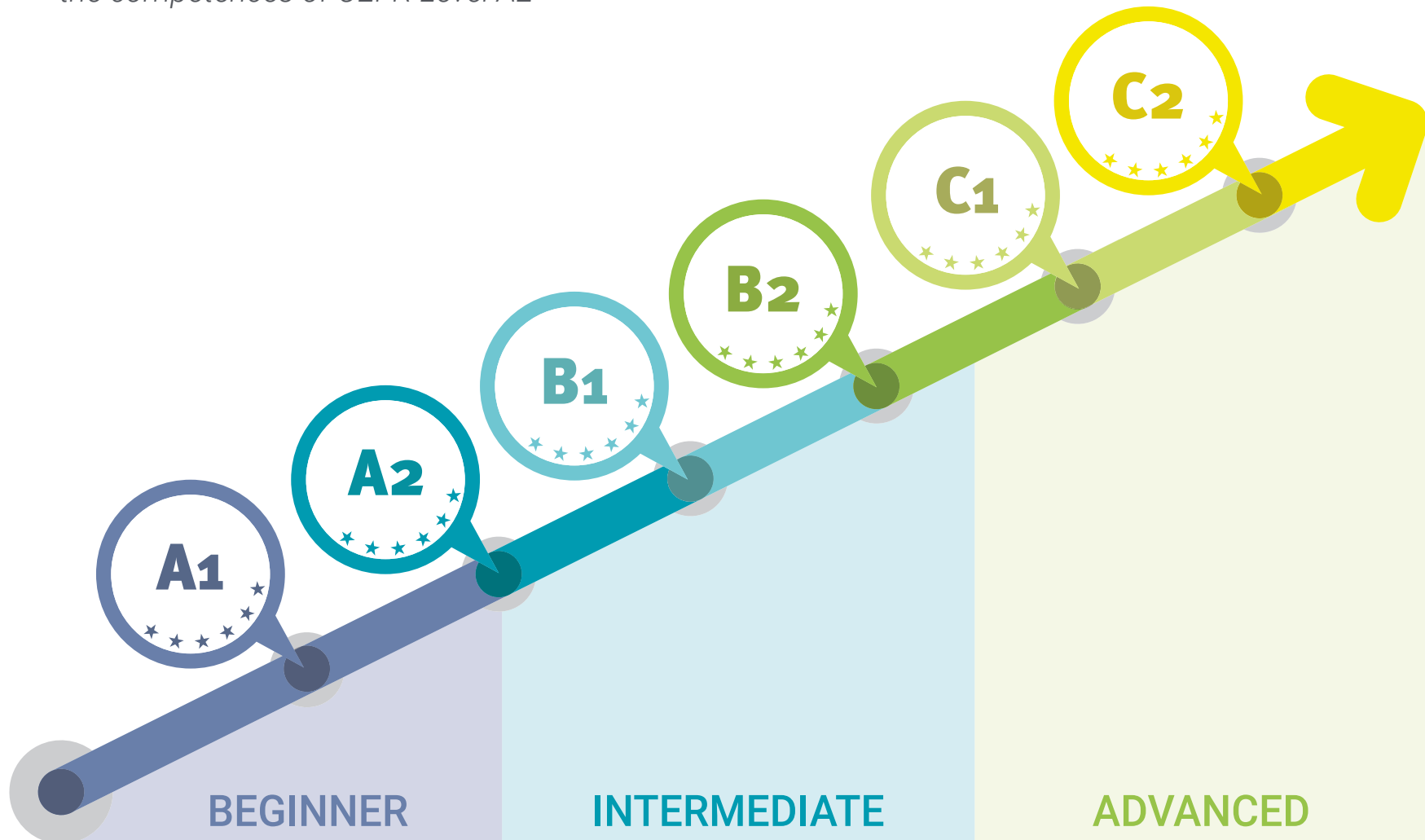

Level A2 is part of the Basic User Level, here you will find descriptors on how to function in social life: being able to carry out simple transactions in stores, post offices or banks; knowing how to get simple travel information; using public transport (buses, trains and cabs); asking for basic information, asking and explaining how to get to a place and buys tickets; ordering and providing everyday goods and services.

What Is Level A2?

Level A2 is part of basic User Level, which is divided into two sublevels: First and Second Basic User Level (A1 and A2). Most of the descriptors that are used in social functions are found at this level, such as, for example:

This implies a cultural immersion that is only possible to recreate in the online format through simulated scenarios, storytelling, videos and real situations.

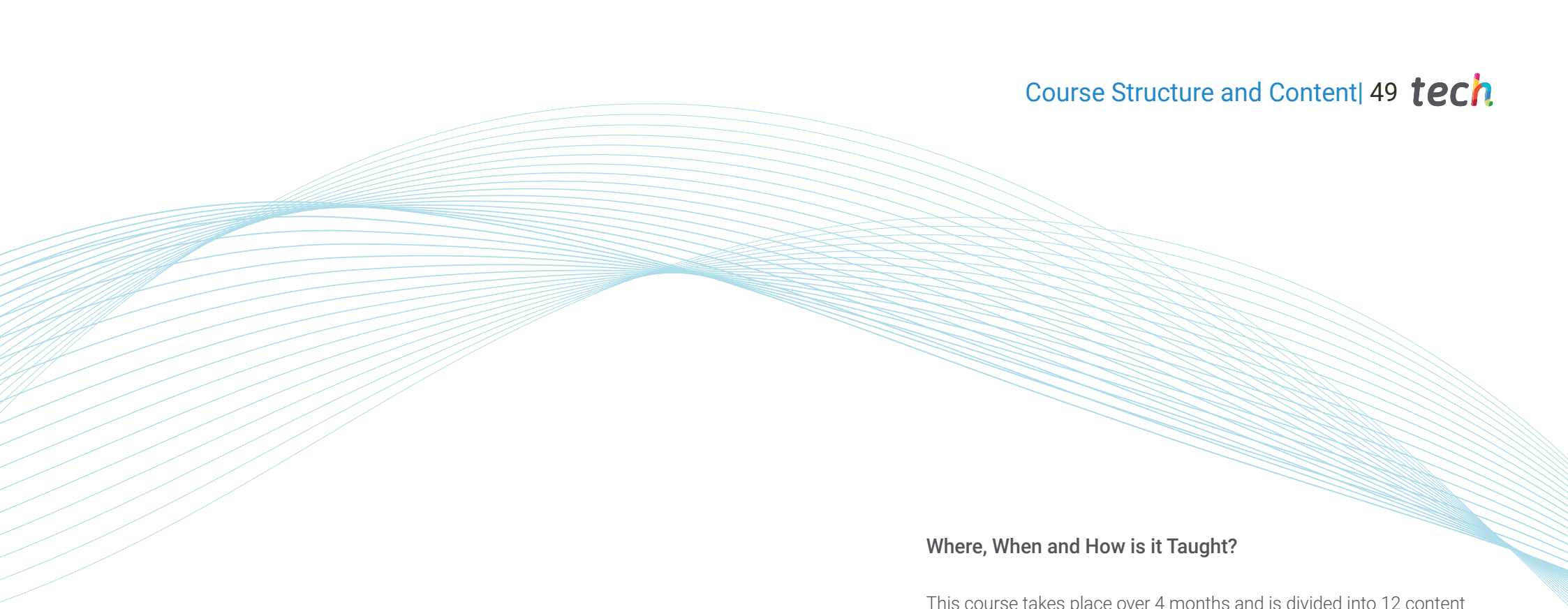

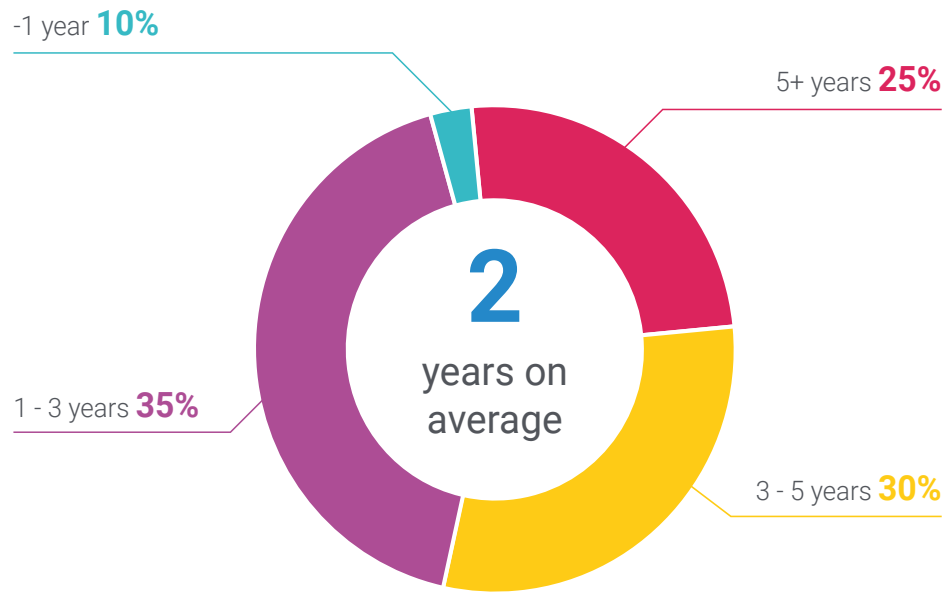




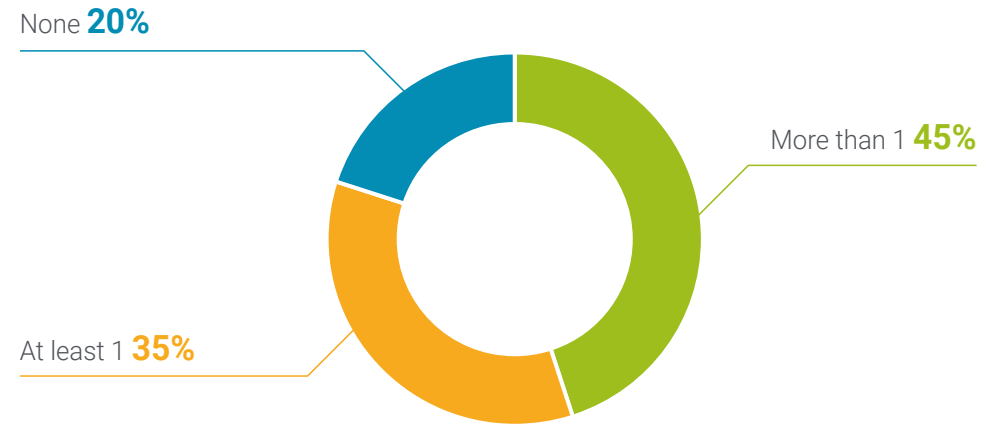

The Professional Benefits of Italian

Italian is a beautiful and romantic language, the language of ancient medieval thinkers, historical writers, and possesses a unique musicality and conceptual richness in a wide variety of fields. It is the language of Dante, Petrarch and Boccaccio, three great Italian writers, but it is also the language of art, history, science, gastronomy and fashion.

As the birthplace of Latinity, Italy played a decisive role in the diffusion of Latin and the culture of the Roman Empire in the rest of Europe, both in Ancient times and in the ages that followed. Similarly, after the affirmation of the Neo-Latin languages and the constitution of modern linguistic Europe, Italian has had, at times, moments of great importance in the international linguistic context.

Approximately 70 million people worldwide speak Italian (60 million in Italy and around 10 million in the rest of the world). It is the official language in Italy, Switzerland, San Marino and Vatican City. It is spoken, at least in part, in eleven countries, to which must be added some twenty countries with a large Italian community, such as Argentina, Germany, Australia and the USA.

Italian is one of the official languages of the European Union, therefore, speaking Italian will open the doors to many international organizations and also the possibility of working in many of the large Italian companies with international presence. The Italian economy is principally based in three sectors, tourism, the automotive industry and fashion.

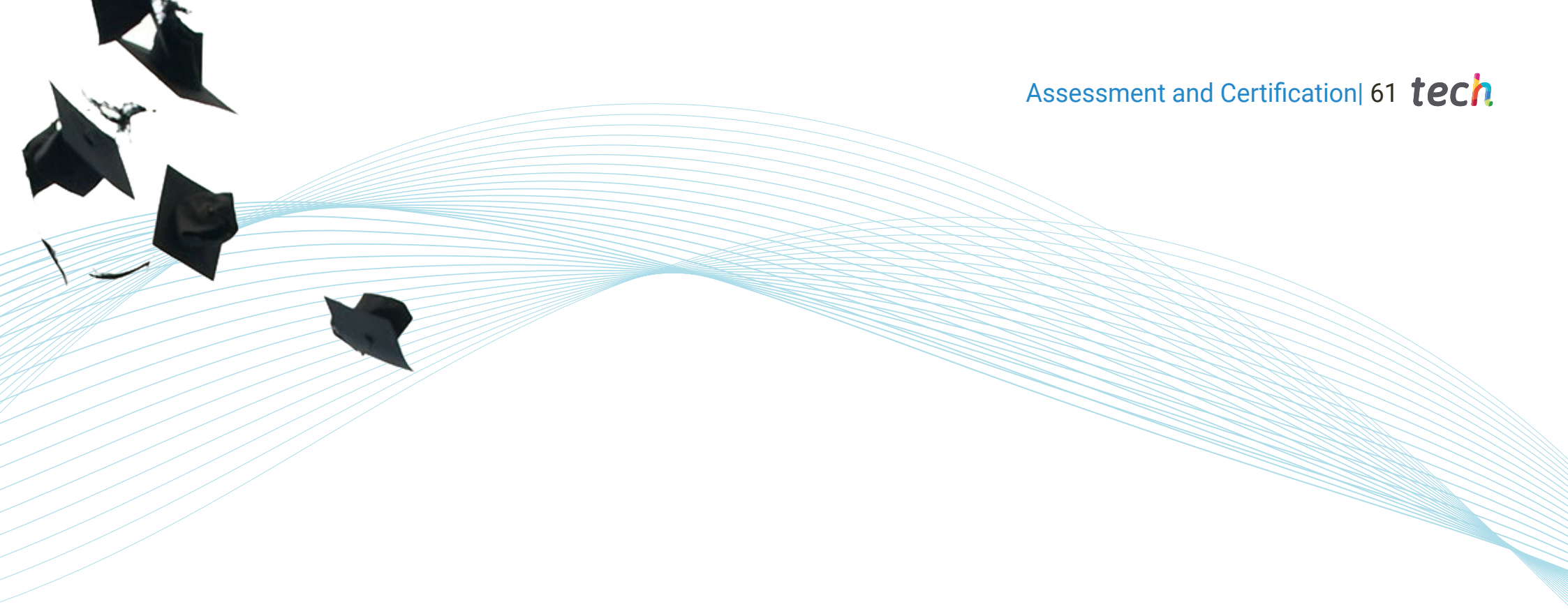
