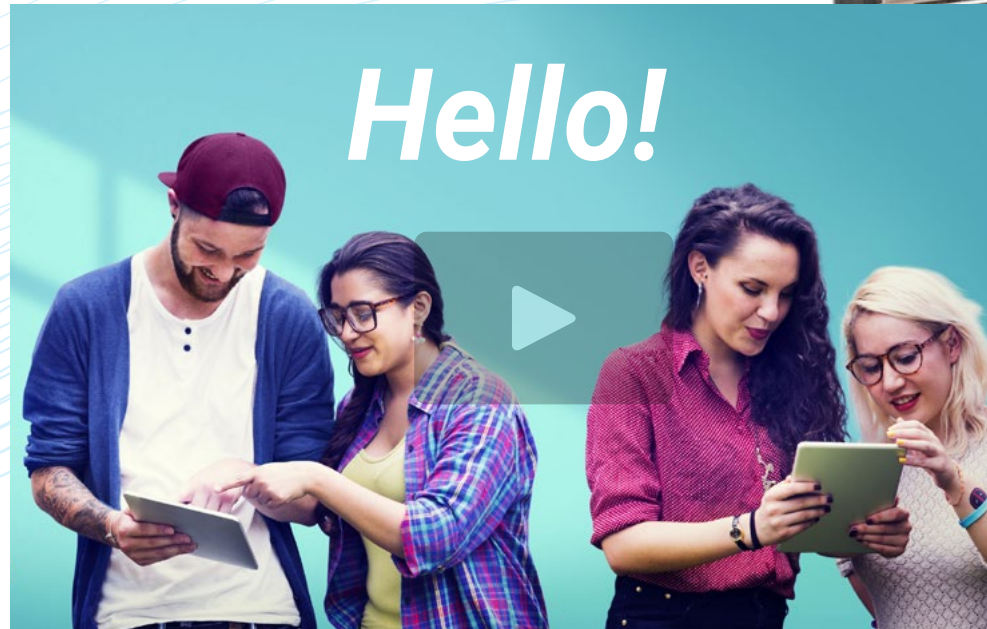

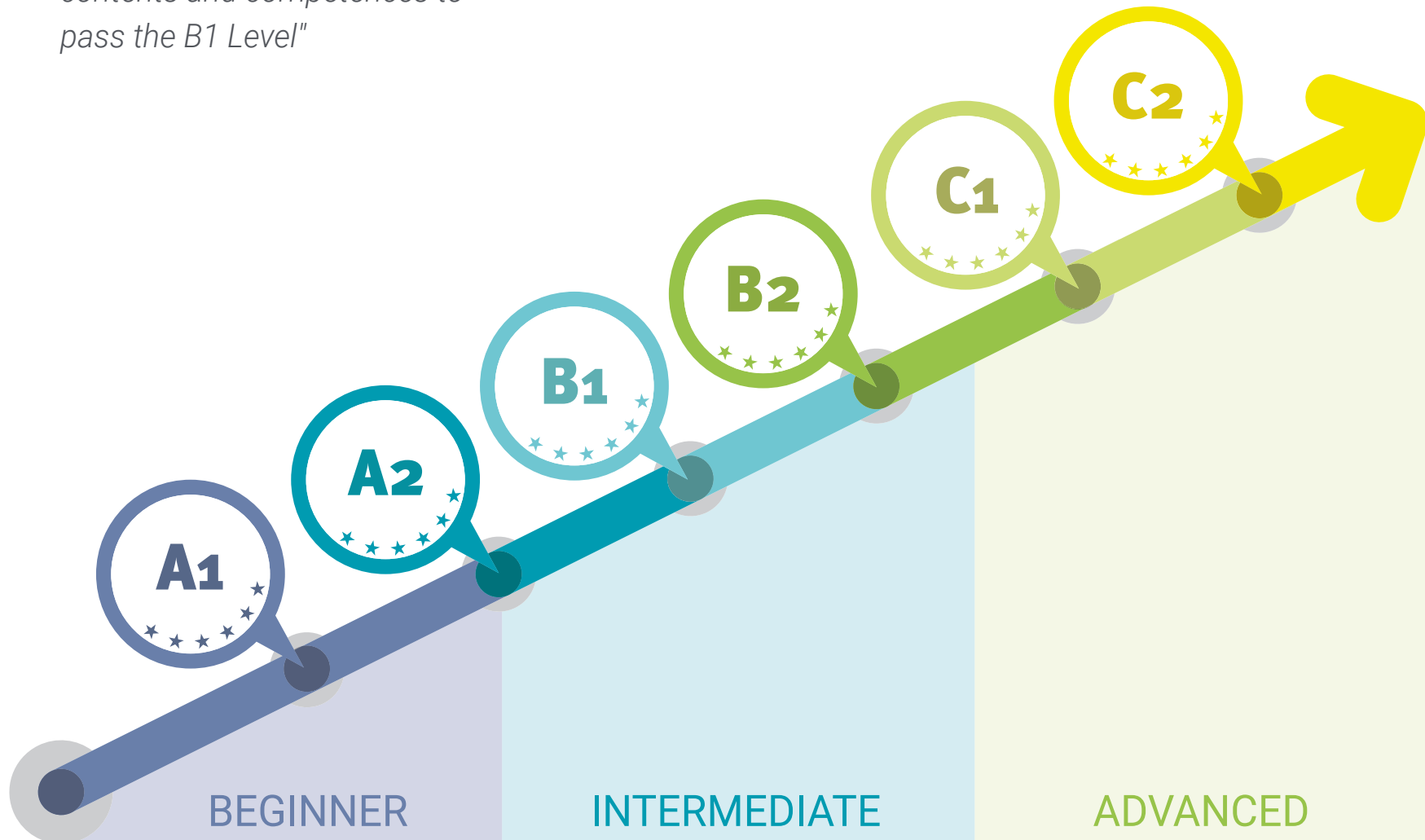

What Is Level B1?

Level B1 is part of the Independent User Level, which is further divided into two sub-levels: First and Second Independent User Level (B1 and B2).

The B1 Level has two main features: the first is the ability to maintain interaction and make oneself understood in a variety of situations, for example: learners generally understand the main ideas of extended discussions around them provided the speech is clearly articulated at a standard language level; they can offer and ask for personal opinions in an informal discussion with friends; clearly express the main idea they want to get across; flexibly use broad, simple language to express much of what they want; they are able to carry on a conversation or discussion, but can sometimes be difficult to understand when trying to say exactly what they mean; express themselves understandably, although pauses for some grammatical and lexical planning and mistake-correcting is evident, especially in long periods language flow.

The second feature is the ability to know how to deal flexibly with everyday problems, such as, for example: coping with less common situations in public transport, the typical situations that often arise when making travel reservations through an agency or when traveling; participates in conversations on usual matters without having anticipated it; being able to raise complaints; taking the initiative in an interview or consultation (e.g., knows how to initiate a new topic), although still being noticeably dependent on the interviewer during the interaction; knowing how to ask someone to clarify or develop what he or she has just said.

Oral Comprehension

- ♦ Understand concrete everyday or work-related information, and identify, both the general message and specific details as long as the speech is clearly articulated and with a normal accent
- ♦ Understand the main ideas of clear, standard speech on everyday topics related to work, school or leisure time, including short narratives.
- ♦ Generally follow the main ideas of a long discussion going on around them, provided that the discourse is clearly articulated at a standard language level
- ♦ Understand, in general terms, simple and short speeches on everyday topics, provided they are delivered with standard and clear pronunciation
- ♦ Understand a lecture or talk that deals with their area of expertise, provided that the subject matter is familiar and the presentation is simple and clearly structured
- ♦ Understand simple technical information, such as operating instructions for frequently used appliances, as well as follow detailed instructions
- ♦ Understand the main ideas of radio news and other simpler recorded material dealing with everyday topics delivered relatively slowly and clearly.
- ♦ Understand the information content of most recorded or broadcast material related to topics of personal interest with clear standard pronunciation



Oral Expression

- ♦ Carry out, with a reasonable degree of fluency, a simple description of a variety of topics that are of interest to them, presenting them as a linear sequence of elements
- ♦ Give simple descriptions on a variety of common topics within your specialty
- ♦ Give simple narratives or descriptions with a reasonable degree of fluency following a linear sequence of elements
- ♦ Make detailed accounts of experiences describing feelings and reactions.
- ♦ Report the details of unpredictable events, such as, for example, an accident
- ♦ Relate book or movie plots and describe your reactions to them
- ♦ Describe dreams, hopes and ambitions
- ♦ Describe real or imagined events. Tell stories
- ♦ Provide brief rationales and explanations for opinions, plans and actions.
- ♦ Develop arguments well enough so that they can be understood without difficulty most of the time.
- ♦ Make short rehearsed statements on a relevant topic within their specialty, which are clearly intelligible despite being accompanied by an unmistakably foreign accent and intonation
- ♦ Deliver a brief, prepared presentation on a topic within their specialty, with sufficient clarity to be followed without difficulty most of the time and whose main ideas are explained with reasonable accuracy. Can also answer supplemental questions, but may have to ask for repetition if spoken quickly

Specific Objectives

Sociocultural and Sociolinguistic Competence

- ◆ Know how to carry out a wide variety of linguistic functions, using the most common exponents of these functions in a neutral register.
- ◆ Be aware of the most important rules of courtesy and act appropriately.
- ◆ Be aware of the most significant differences that exist between the customs, usages, attitudes, values and beliefs prevailing in the community in question and their own, and know how to identify such differences.
- ◆ Know how to carry out basic language functions such as exchanging and requesting information and expressing opinions and attitudes in a simple way.
- ◆ Adapt their expression to deal with less common and even difficult situations. Use a wide range of simple linguistic elements with the flexibility to express much of what is wanted.
- ◆ Intervene in debates on everyday topics using an appropriate phrase to take the floor. Initiate, maintain and end simple face-to-face conversations on everyday topics or of personal interest
- ◆ Perform, with reasonable fluency, simple narratives or descriptions, through a linear sequence of elements
- ◆ Link a series of short, specific and simple elements to enable a linear sequence of related ideas

Linguistic Competence

- ◆ Have sufficient linguistic elements to describe unpredictable situations, to explain the main points of an idea or problem with reasonable accuracy, and to express thoughts on abstract or cultural topics, such as music and movies.
- ◆ Have enough linguistic elements to get by and enough vocabulary to express themselves with some hesitation and circumlocution on topics such as family, hobbies and interests, work, travel and current events, but lexical limitations cause repetition and sometimes even difficulties in formulation.
- ◆ Have sufficient vocabulary to express themselves with some circumlocution on most topics relevant to their daily lives, such as family, hobbies and interests, work, travel, and current events.
- ◆ Demonstrate a good command of elementary vocabulary, even if significant errors are made when expressing more complex thoughts, or when dealing with unusual topics and situations.
- ◆ Communicate with reasonable accuracy in everyday situations; generally have good grammatical control, although with an obvious influence of the native language
- ◆ Use with reasonable accuracy a repertoire of commonly used "formulas " and structures associated with predictable situations
- ◆ Have a clearly intelligible pronunciation, even if their foreign accent is sometimes evident and sporadic mispronunciations are made.

Communicative competence is not merely limited to the knowledge and ability to use the linguistic code, but has other broader dimensions, which place it in direct relation with other competences such as information processing and digital competence, learning to learn, social and civic competence, or cultural and artistic competence.

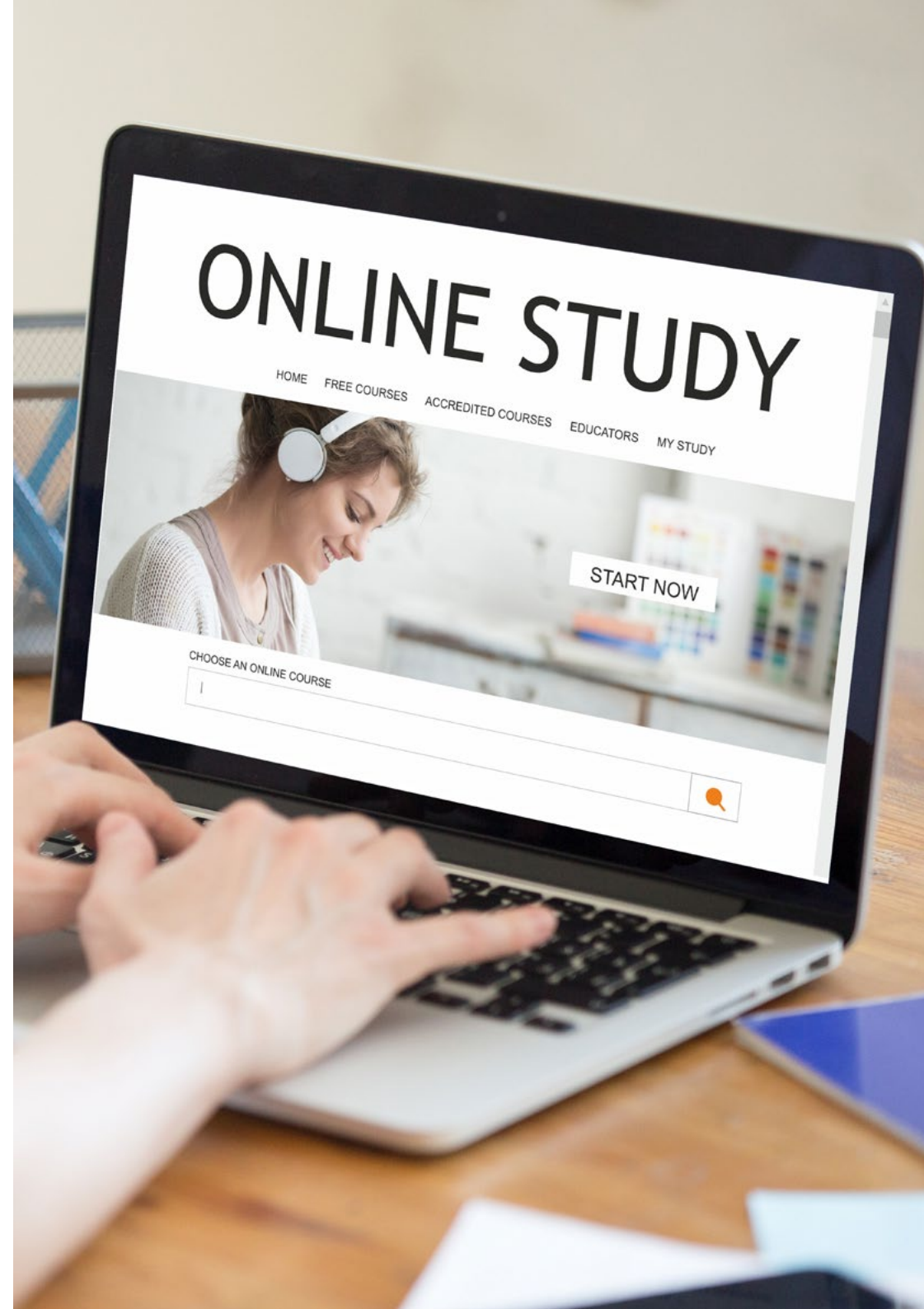
B1 Level Learning Objectives
