



03 What Is the B2 Level?

Level B2 is part of the Independent User Level, which is further divided into two sub-levels: First and Second Independent User Level (B1 and B2).

Level B2 has two main characteristics: The first is the ability to maintain interaction and make oneself understood in a variety of situations; for example: generally understand the main ideas of extended discussions around them as long as the speech is clearly articulated at standard language level; offer and ask for personal opinions in an informal discussion with friends; express the main idea they want to get across; flexibly use broad, simple language to express much of what they want; is able to carry on a conversation or discussion, but can sometimes be difficult to understand when trying to say exactly what they want; express themselves understandably, although pauses for some grammatical and lexical planning and correctness are evident, especially in long periods of spontaneous speech.

Scope

Have a sufficiently broad level of language to be able to provide clear descriptions and express points of view on general topics without obvious pauses to search for a word, and knowing how to use complex sentences to achieve this.

Correction

Demonstrate relatively high grammatical accuracy.

Not make mistakes that cause misunderstanding and be able to correct almost all mistakes made.

Fluency

Be capable of producing fragments of a speech with a fairly uniform rhythm; although there could be pauses while thinking of certain structures or expressions.

Make very few long pauses while speaking.

Interaction

Start a conversation, take your turn to speak at the appropriate moment and finish a conversation when necessary, although it may not always be done with elegance.

Participate in debates on day to day topics, demonstrating understanding, inviting others to participate, etc.

Coherence

Use a limited number of cohesion mechanisms to turn sentences into a clear and coherent speech, although there may be some "nervousness" if the speech is long.


