01 Introduction

In veterinary practices, specialization in feline patients is increasingly in demand, as cats are, together with dogs, the main pets in most households. In this sense, the increasing demand from owners who are looking for professionals with a high qualification in pathologies related to felines forces veterinarians to obtain a higher and specialized training, which allows them to act with greater safety and guarantees of success. Thus, TECH has created a pioneering pedagogical model that allows its students to stay in a first level veterinary clinic or hospital. Throughout 3 weeks in these centers, they will incorporate the most updated trends and tools for the care of cat pets into their professional practice.

In higher veterinary university education, there are few curriculums that deal in depth with the anatomical complexities and most frequent pathologies in felines. In most cases, professionals who specialize in this area must seek postgraduate courses that emphasize theoretical contents and do not reinforce the development of skills for this type of care practice. Some of them only refer to the current techniques of medical and surgical intervention for cats and ignore the most modern trends in this field. However, an increasing number of veterinarians wish to specialize in the care of the domestic feline population and set up their own veterinary practices.

General Objectives

- ◆ Master the specific anesthetic techniques for each particular case depending on the surgical procedure to be performed on the feline patient
- ◆ Incorporate to the daily work the most current nutritional issues in domestic cats that allow a better recovery of the animal submitted to surgical interventions

Specific Objectives

 - ♦ Generate advanced expertise regarding hyperthyroidism, diabetes, hyperaldosteronism and hypercalcemia in cats
 - ♦ Establish the correct clinical and diagnostic approaches for each of the above diseases
 - ♦ Examine the appropriate diagnostic methods in each case and correctly interpret the results of laboratory and imaging tests
 - ♦ Determine the most current treatments for the control or cure of each pathology to be each of the pathologies to be treated in cats
 - ♦ Develop a protocol to identify and localize the main alterations affecting the nervous system in the feline species
 - ♦ Evaluate the differential diagnoses that most frequently affect the nervous system of feline patients
 - ♦ Examine the main techniques available for the surgical treatment of patients alterations of the nervous system
- ♦ Establish the new therapeutic alternatives applied to infectious diseases in cats based on the latest scientific evidence
 - ♦ Deepen in the management of bacterial infections, determining the most significant differences in diagnosis and treatment
 - ♦ Distinguish between a physiological and an inflammatory leukogram for cats

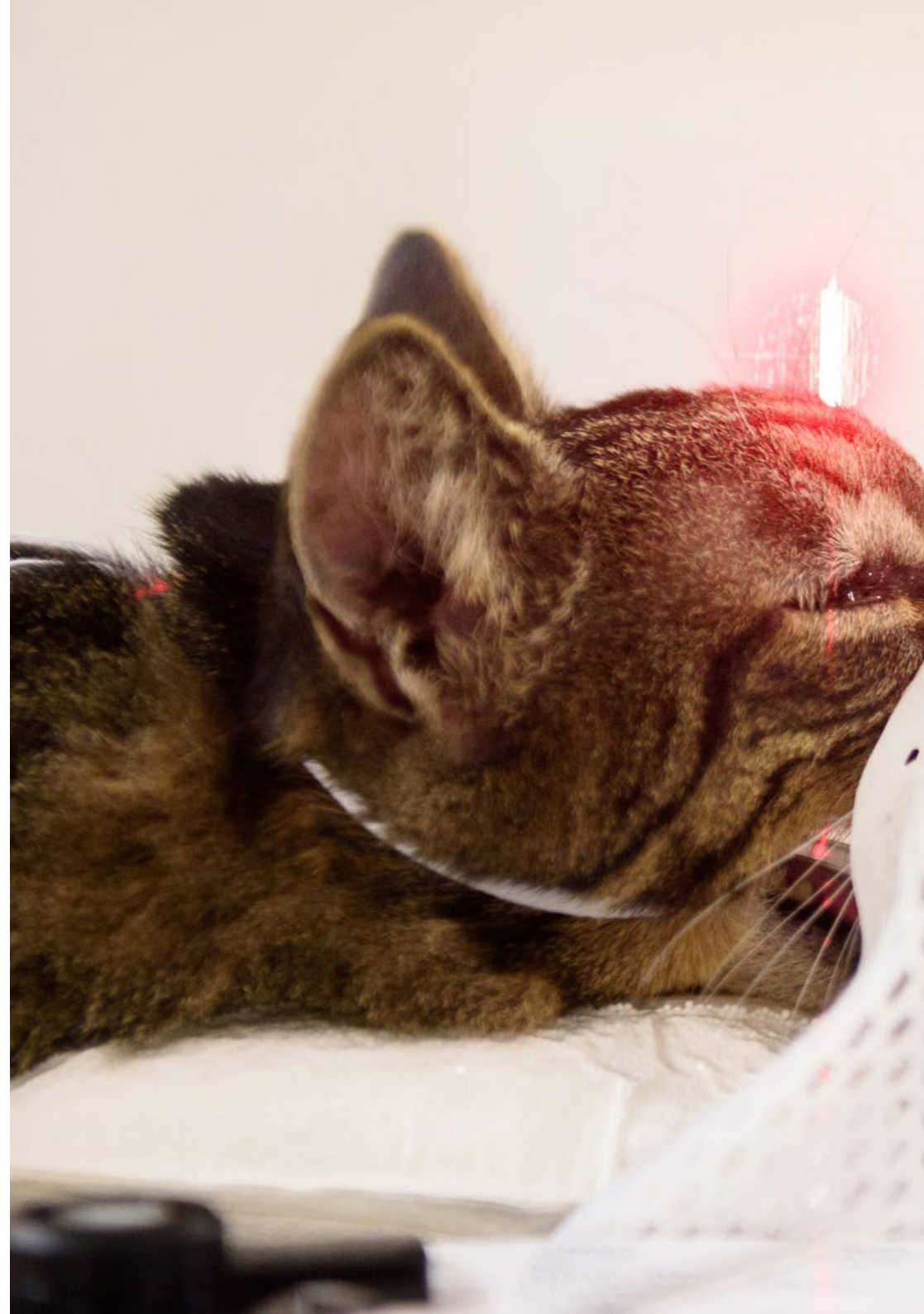
04 Educational Plan

The Internship Program in Feline Medicine and Surgery consists of a practical stay in a prestigious center, lasting 3 weeks, from Monday to Friday with 8 consecutive hours of practical learning. This stay will allow them to see real cases alongside a professional team of reference in the veterinary area, applying the most innovative medical and surgical procedures of last generation.

In this training proposal, of a completely practical nature, the activities are aimed at developing and perfecting the necessary skills for the provision of veterinary care, and are oriented towards specific training for the practice of the activity, in an environment of safety for the patient and high professional performance.

The student will be accompanied by an assistant tutor of high prestige throughout the whole of this on-site stay. This specialist will be in charge of supervising their academic and practical progress in a demanding veterinary environment. In this way, students will have access to real cases that they will assimilate immediately. Through them, they will be able to learn in depth all the surgical methods that they will have to apply in their daily professional practice.

The practical teaching will be carried out with the active participation of the student performing the activities and procedures of each area of competence (learning to learn and learning to do), with the accompaniment and guidance of the professors and other training partners that facilitate teamwork and multidisciplinary integration as transversal competencies for veterinary practice (learning to be and learning to relate).

	Apply electrochemotherapy for feline surgical intervention
Oncology techniques in the feline patient	Address low grade and high grade lymphomas in the cat
	Evaluate mammary carcinoma and enhance imaging in feline pulmonary neoplasms
	Perform cytology applied to feline oncology

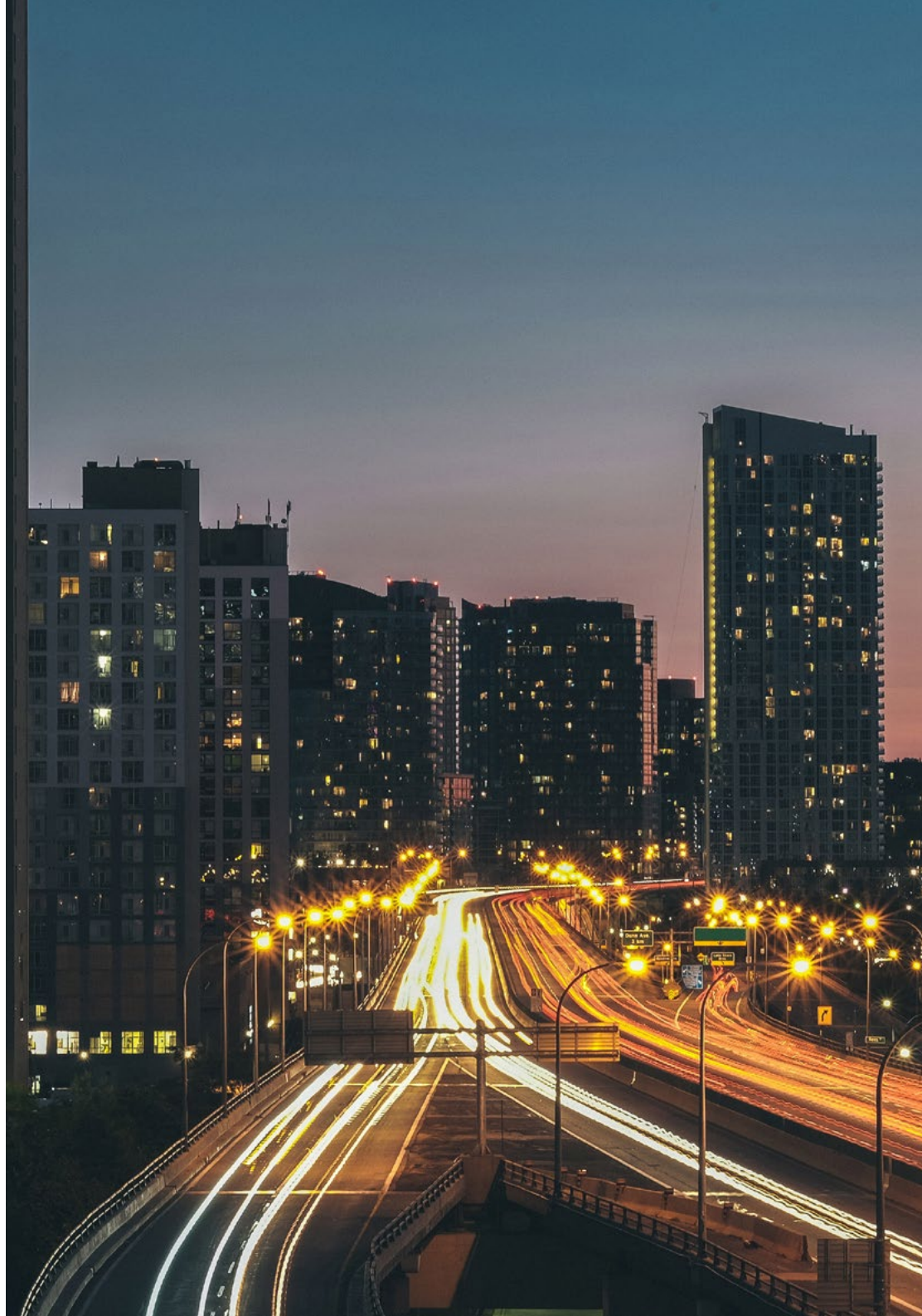

06 General Conditions

Civil Liability Insurance

This institution's main concern is to guarantee the safety of the trainees and other collaborating agents involved in the internship process at the company. Among the measures dedicated to achieve this is the response to any incident that may occur during the entire teaching-learning process.

To this end, this entity commits to purchasing a civil liability insurance policy to cover any eventuality that may arise during the course of the internship at the center.

This liability policy for interns will have broad coverage and will be taken out prior to the start of the internship program period. That way professionals will not have to worry in case of having to face an unexpected situation and will be covered until the end of the internship program at the center.



General Conditions of the Internship Program

The general terms and conditions of the internship agreement for the program are as follows:

1. TUTOR: During the Internship Program, students will be assigned with two tutors who will accompany them throughout the process, answering any doubts and questions that may arise. On the one hand, there will be a professional tutor belonging to the internship center who will have the purpose of guiding and supporting the student at all times. On the other hand, they will also be assigned with an academic tutor, whose mission will be to coordinate and help the students during the whole process, solving doubts and facilitating everything they may need. In this way, the student will be accompanied and will be able to discuss any doubts that may arise, both clinical and academic.

2. DURATION: The internship program will have a duration of three continuous weeks, in 8-hour days, 5 days a week. The days of attendance and the schedule will be the responsibility of the center and the professional will be informed well in advance so that they can make the appropriate arrangements.

3. ABSENCE: If the students does not show up on the start date of the Internship Program, they will lose the right to it, without the possibility of reimbursement or change of dates. Absence for more than two days from the internship, without justification or a medical reason, will result in the professional's withdrawal from the internship, therefore, automatic termination of the internship. Any problems that may arise during the course of the internship must be urgently reported to the academic tutor.

4. CERTIFICATION: Professionals who pass the Internship Program will receive a certificate accrediting their stay at the center.

5. EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP: The Internship Program shall not constitute an employment relationship of any kind.

6. PRIOR EDUCATION: Some centers may require a certificate of prior education for the Internship Program. In these cases, it will be necessary to submit it to the TECH internship department so that the assignment of the chosen center can be confirmed.

7. DOES NOT INCLUDE: The Internship Program will not include any element not described in the present conditions. Therefore, it does not include accommodation, transportation to the city where the internship takes place, visas or any other items not listed.

However, students may consult with their academic tutor for any questions or recommendations in this regard. The academic tutor will provide the student with all the necessary information to facilitate the procedures in any case.
